

Grayhaven Sail Club 2016 Trip Schedule

May 27-30 Weekend at Belle River Marina, Canada. **Slip reservations required, so please confirm with Harold Weaver in advance if you plan to attend and will need a boat slip.** Marina has on-site restaurant, grills and picnic tables, bicycle rentals. Marina is also within walking distance of the Town's shopping and dining. **NOTE: proper Border Crossing documentation required.**

June 11-12 Overnight at Markley's Marina in Clinton Township with dinner just down the road at MacRay's Restaurant. Slip reservations required. **Confirm attendance with Joe Moran. 734-502-8401.** Marina has restrooms and showers, also picnic tables.

June 25-26 Metro Beach with optional overnight. Slip reservations suggested but not required in advance. Food and drink available for purchase. Access to beach and pool available. **Confirm attendance with Joe Moran. 734-502-8401.** Marina has restrooms and showers, also picnic tables.

July 5 - 8 4-day weekend in Leamington, Canada. **Slip reservations required, so please confirm with Harold Weaver in advance if you plan to attend and will need a boat slip.** The plan is leave early from Kean's in the morning. Leamington Marina has no on-site food services, but restaurants are within a short walking distance, bicycle rentals available. There may also be available a ferry ride to Pelee Island for the winery tour. **NOTE: proper Border Crossing documentation required.**

July 15 Bus Trip to Port Huron Blue Water Festival, tours of several Port Huron sights, including the Bramble Ice Cutter and Port Huron Lighthouse and viewing Mackinaw race boats. Bus to leave from Kean's around 11am with box lunches on bus, evening meal available for purchase in Port Huron. Returning to Kean's around 9 or 10p.m. **Cost for bus and box lunches to be determined and will need to be paid in advance.**

August 25 – Sept 1 6-day trip to Lexington and Grand Bend on Lake Huron. Plan is to dock overnight at Port Huron on the 25th. The stop at Port Huron is only for overnight dockage, leaving early (6:30am) on August 26th for Lexington. Lexington has several restaurants within walking distance from the marina for meals; also grills are available in the park near the marina; in town are a grocery, boutique shops and a winery/brewery which offers tastings; also sometimes free live entertainment at the park on weekends. Leave Lexington early on Aug. 29th to cross Lake Huron for Grand Bend for two days. Leave for home on morning of Sept. 1st, with possible overnight dockage again at Port Huron before heading home. **Slip reservations required in advance at both Lexington and Grand Bend, so please confirm with Joe Moran 734-502-8401 in advance if you plan to attend.**

September 9-12 4-day weekend to Belle River – Thames, Canada. **Slip reservations required at both, so please confirm with Harold Weaver 313 671-5676 in advance if you plan to attend.** The plan is to spend 1-1/2 days at Belle River, then one day at the Thames River Club, then back home. **NOTE: proper Border Crossing documentation required.**
